When: Ongoing with orders placed monthly

Who: Donna Pittman, Marcia Gustafson, and many customers within the congregation

How: Order forms and price lists are available in a notebook on the narthex table. The products include coffee, tea, hot chocolate, chocolate bars, almonds, and dried cranberries. Orders are gathered into case lots of six packages, to keep shipping charges to a minimum. Order forms may be placed in Donna's mailbox in the church office. Payment is made when the order is picked up from church.
